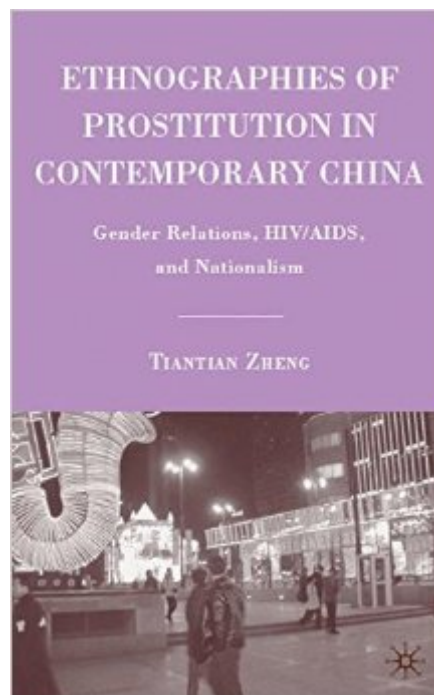


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Ethnographies Of Prostitution In Contemporary China: Gender Relations, HIV/AIDS, And Nationalism
