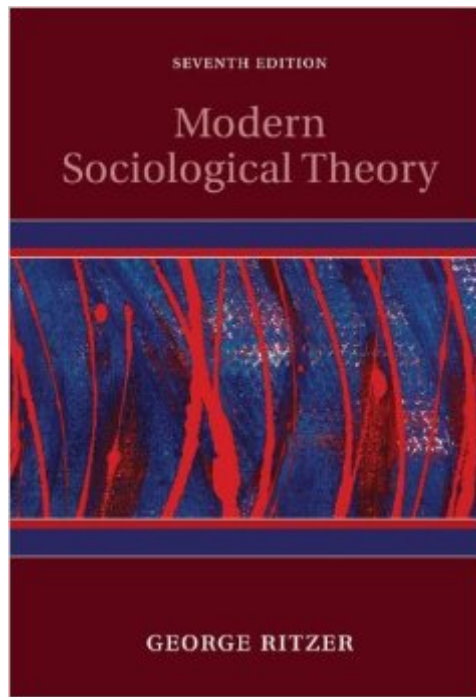


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Modern Sociological Theory

The seventh edition of *Modern Sociological Theory* by George Ritzer, one of the foremost authorities on sociological theory, gives readers a comprehensive overview of the major contemporary schools of sociological thought. Key theories are integrated with biographical sketches of theorists, and theories are placed in their historical and intellectual context. This helps students to better understand the original works and helps them appreciate the diversity of contemporary theory.

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Very few people can pack so many complex theories and explain their nuances so well in such a simple, clear manner. This is not to say that the book is a 'simple read,' because the theories and the tensions are extremely complex and muddled. But anyone who has read the original readings--pick Foucault, Baudrillard, Garfinkel, or whoever you like--would appreciate how CLEAR Ritzer and Goodman are. This book provides a gateway and an invitation to complex theoretical thoughts. It is also an authoritative and reliable reference text.
